

The Blizzard of 1993...

Beginning on March 13th, Blizzard of 1993, also referred to as the "snow-icane" or "storm of the century". slammed northeastern and central Pennsylvania with heavy snow and hurricane-force winds coming in at 45-65 mph. Pocono Lake recorded a record high 38.5" of snow in 3 days, which is currently still the highest on record!

Dam break in 1994...

On April 27, 1994, dozens of people were evacuated from their homes after a small hole developed in a dam along Arrowhead Lake. The 5-foot hole was large enough to cause water levels to rise without flooding. The hole allowed considerable amounts of water to flow from Arrowhead Lake into Trout Creek. authorities asked people living along Trout Creek and the Lehigh River to leave their homes until mid-afternoon.

Workers were able to plug the hole using rocks and dirt from a nearby quarry, and a more permanent patch was constructed. There were no damaged homes or injuries.


