The lakes at Arrowhead are a precious resource and all in the community are tasked with their stewardship. We need everyone's support to ensure our lakes are preserved along with the surrounding ecosystem by following some simple rules and guidelines. While we are a private community, all PA Fish and Boat Commission rules must be followed for lifejackets, boat registration, fishing licenses (required for anyone fishing the lake that is 16 years and over), seasons, sizes, and limits.



Common Species in the Lake

(Trout, Bass and Walleye are stocked)

- Clean up your trash to protect our lake environment
- For enhanced breeding, Arrowhead asks all Bass under 20" be released
- Release all under size fish after landing – Except Carp
- Practice CRUSH the BARB on hooks for fish health
- **Destroy all CARP** – they are an invasive species damaging the lakes
