

Important Information for your safety and well-being of our lakes

All lakes in PA must follow the PA Fish and Boat Commission rules (<https://www.fishandboat.com>)

- Conservation **officers** routinely **monitor** the **lake** and issue warnings and fines for **violations**

SUMMARY OF IMPORTANT PENNSYLVANIA BOATING RULES

- Every **boat** must carry a **life jacket for all onboard**
 - Boats include: pontoon, row, sail, pedal, kayaks, canoes, paddle board
- Children **12 and under** must **wear a life jacket** on boats 20' and under **all the time**
- Life Jackets **must be worn** by **all** aboard between **November 1st and April 30th**
- **All** boats over **16'** or any boat with a motor **must** be registered with a state
- **Floats**, if towed by any boat or using paddles, must follow the **same** rules

SUMMARY OF IMPORTANT PENNSYLVANIA FISHING RULES

- A **Pennsylvania** Fishing License is required by anyone **16** and older
- An additional **TROUT** Stamp is required if you keep any trout
- For **PA** size limits on fish commonly found in Arrowhead Lakes – see reverse

ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE FOR THE CONTINUED HEALTH OF OUR LAKES & FISH

- **Clean up** your trash to **protect** our **lake** environment
- For enhanced breeding, Arrowhead asks all **Bass** under **20"** be **Catch & Release**
- Release all under size fish after landing – Except Carp
- **Practice CRUSH** the **BARB** on hooks for fish **health**
- **Destroy** all **CARP** – they are an invasive species damaging the lakes
